Eastbourne Symphony Orchestra

For the past twelve years, the Eastbourne Symphony Orchestra has been providing the town with quality concerts. Formerly known as the Eastbourne Sinfonia, the orchestra now numbers in excess of 70 players who come from all over the South East region, though mainly from Eastbourne and the surrounding area.

The orchestra's fundamental aims are twofold; namely, to promote interest in music in and around Eastbourne and to encourage musicians - particularly the young starting out on their careers - to advance musical education through live performance. To this end, the Orchestra registered as a charity in 1987, and the Eastbourne Borough Council allots a substantial grant each year in recognition of the orchestra's contribution to the life of the community. Furthermore, South East Arts recognises the orchestra's value to the area, and financial support is received annually from this quarter, too.

The Choral Concert is an annual event and always attracts many local singers. As last year, we have been very pleased to welcome Colin Tarn of Hailsham Choral Society as Chorus Master and also Jane Mansergh as rehearsal accompanist.

For this Concert, the orchestra is particularly indebted to David Salmon for a most generous sponsorship.
