**The ESO Young Soloist Competition** was established in 1988 as a result of the 11th Duke of Devonshire's financial generosity towards the ESO, to offer young soloists the opportunity of performing with an orchestra. In the 29 years of its existence, the competition has created an ever-growing interest throughout the country and abroad, with an increasingly high standard of entry. The competition is open to competitors aged 23 and under and carries a first prize of £800. The winner also has the opportunity to perform a concerto with the ESO at a concert later in the year. Runner-up prizes include the Cox Memorial Prize of £500, the Colonel Howes Award of £350, the St Cecilia Bequest of £250, and further prizes of £150 each. The best performance given by a competitor under the age of 18 will win the Duke of Devonshire Award (a prize of £300).
