The ESO Young Soloist Competition was established in 1988 as a result of the 11th Duke of Devonshire's financial generosity towards the ESO, to offer young soloists the opportunity of performing with an orchestra. Over the past three decades, the competition has created an ever-growing interest throughout the country and abroad, with an increasingly high standard of entry. The competition is open to competitors aged 23 and under and carries a first prize of £800. The winner also has the opportunity to perform a concerto with the ESO at a concert later in the year. Further prizes include the Cox Memorial Award of £500, the Colonel Howes Award of £350 and runner-up prizes of £150 each. The best performances given by competitors under the age of 18 win the St Cecilia Bequest of £300 and the Duke of Devonshire Award of £250.
